Laser Training with Dr. Larry Lytle

A woman who purchased a laser system from us has asked if we would check into a high power laser treatment plan which, she has been told, will 'wipe out' her gum disease as well as augment the use of the Q1000 laser system. Could you take a look at this procedure so we can get back to this woman?

Yes I am familiar with the Perolase technique. In fact the guys that patented that laser technique and laser system heard me present on what I called laser assisted root planning in the early 1990s at an organizational dental laser meeting in Acapulco Mexico.

The technique does work, but may be circumvented by applying the 660 Enhancer in conjunction with root planning and good home care and wearing MBTs. If this technique does not get the expected results then the patient can go for the more expensive Periolas procedure.

It is a video interview with a prominent Italian oncologist expanding on his alternative views. While Dr. Tullio Simoncini's treatment is not main stream, his contention that cancer is a fungus created by an acid environment which can be treated with Sodium Bicarbonate (Baking Soda)

via a catheter injection makes good sense. Since western medicine has not made any headway treating cancer with chemotherapy and radiation, it is time to look elsewhere for answers. This theory adds credence to my work in using the Q1000 to change the body's acid pH by delivering electrons back to the site. Please review the section of my lecture on the Hydrogen Atom explaining that losing an electron creates a Hydrogen Ion which is acidic and also review the section explaining that oxidation is also the loss of electrons. The greatest Physicists do not know all the reasons the atoms which make up our cells lose electrons and become acidic. But REMEMBER the Q1000 laser puts electrons back and normalizes pH and the oxidation process. While Dr. Tullio Simoncini's approach is somewhat simple with minimal invasion, applying the Q1000 is so simple it can be accomplished at home by a 6 year old. Fear and worry of cancer causes stress and stress is known to cause loss of electrons creating an acidic environment – a vicious circle – which can be treated preventively with regular use of the Q1000. Read my Low Level Laser User's Manual under prevention or maintenance.

Thanks for taking my call regarding renal arterial stenosis. Was at Cleve. Clinic on thurs. Met with nation's #1 urology surgeon-- Dr. Novich. Very bad diagnosis, 85% narrowing in almost exact middle of artery. Rest of artery ok. Most likely rare form of smooth muscle tissue attack but angiogram inconclusive. My nephrologist Dr. Pohl did not rule out plaque but doubts it very much. Clinic is leaning toward renal arterial bypass but won't rule out a ballon without a stent. Say I have 2-3 years until I lose kidney if nothing done. Do not have much faith in duration of ballon or in ability to reduce medication enough said Pohl. But still may give a shot.

Also said me being in good shape is a plus for surgery. I have been using Q-1000 for 1 week on artery from the back on mode3. For 3 weeks have been using on heart for arrhythmia in mode 2. No question a slight improvement in less wild and fast majority (not all) of the time. ABSOLUTELY has given me more energy as I ran 3 times last week---first time since late may. My blood pressure. The main renal symptom, would not go lower than 130/90 2 weeks ago. This week after running and even walking I had scores of 95/65,105/50 and even 103/78 after 2 hours of yoga breathing. The vast majority of my scores were pretty good--say 128/83 although I do still score high when I first wake up. After 5-10 minutes, it starts to normalize slightly. I take my monitor with me most of the time. My improvement may be due to medication finally kicking in hard? My questions to you are as follows: Can the laser actually reverse this muscle tissue encroachment? it would seem to me if the muscle tissue is tight it might but if the tissue is already relaxed it would not help. Can the laser prevent a re-stenosis in the renal area if a ballon is inserted? If you said 'yes' to my 1st question, how long should it take before I can expect substantial improvement and feel comfortable requesting another mri/mra? I have had this problem for 1 year. Lastly, I am sure I saw on the dvd that other countries--maybe India-- come up thru a vein in the groin and use laser light to fix arteries. Is this only for plaque in coronary arteries? If I recall the procedure costs about 4000 dollars. What do you know about this?

This is a follow up to our phone call. Please go to [www.qlaserhealinglight.com](http://www qlaserhealinglight.com) and listen to all of the videos and read everything on Dental Distress Syndrome. Read appendix A in your Low Level Laser User's Manual. Order and wear a set of Miracle Bite Tabs to temporarily correct (along with mode 1 of the Q1000) the faulty proprioception. Then the brain can better send signals to the kidney and internal organs. Yes the Q1000 laser will lower your blood pressure, give you more energy and release smooth muscles in arteries (which lowers blood pressure). With the Q1000 and its soliton waves that flow through the body,

there is no need to go to India and put a laser through a vein, just use your Q1000 as directed. Blood pressure varies depending on when it is taken and how ... and your "fear levels" I have had consistent blood pressure of 140/92 for most of my 73 years and I am very healthy.

Please can you tell me how best to treat very painful torn cartilage and muscle damage in the rib cage. Also, is there a special mode to help glaucoma, or should I just use mode 1?

For a torn muscle in the rib cage, apply mode 3 of the Q1000 daily for one cycle and repeat and move as necessary to cover the entire area. If the injury involved any head trauma, it is necessary to make and wear Miracle Bite Tabs - see appendix A in your Low Level Laser User's Manual. While you are waiting to get the MBTs made apply mode 1 of the Q1000 to proprioceptive points 1 through 4 as shown on pages 6 and 7 of you manual. It is VERY BENEFICIAL to take 3 Inflamm-A-Way Enzymes three times a day on an empty to remove extra cellular debris. Inflamm-A-Way is available from your Qlaser distributor. For Glaucoma apply mode 1 for 6-8 breaths every other day - take 400Mg Magnesium along with 25 - 50 Mg of Vit B 6 in divided doses morning and night.

A few days ago I had a haemorrhagic posterior vitreous detachment in one eye. Fortunately the retina was not torn. My sight in that eye is affected in that I feel as if I am looking through a cobweb. The ophthalmologist said it will take 4 to 6 weeks to clear but as I am treating it with the Q1000 I am hopeful that it will be quicker. I have been using the Q1000 every other day on mode 1 for 3 mins. Should I continue with this regime or would you recommend an alternative?

Sorry to hear about your eye. Mode 1 for 6-8 breaths every other day for one week --- then repeat twice a week should be enough --- but you can test how often with the "circles" explained in the appendix of my Low Level Laser User's Manual.

Laser Research

Mechanisms of Anti-inflammatory, Immunomodulatory and Wound Healing Effects of Light

In the 1980's, intravascular and extracorporeal laser irradiation of small amounts of patient's own blood was developed in Russia and since that time successfully used for treatment of inflammatory, cardio-vascular, infectious, skin diseases and severe wounds. This suggests that photomodification of blood components plays the key role in light therapy. IN the case of percutaneous (through the skin) application, the visible and IR light penetrating the skin can directly affect the blood circulating in the superficial dense network at a relatively low rate. In our trials we saw: (1) improvement of the rheological, transport, oxygen-transport properties of red blood cells and microcirculation; (2) a decrease in platelet aggregation and upregulation of anticoagulation system; (3) activation of functional state of all types of leukocytes; (4) a dramatic decrease in the plasma content of pro-inflammatory cytokines; (5) enhancement of the growth promoting activity of blood plasma for human keratinocytes, endotheliocytes and fibroblasts; (6) activation of DNA-repair system in injured target cells; and (7) these changes developed at contact of the circulating blood with a small amount of transcutaneously photomodified blood that is able to transfer the light-induced effects to unirradiated blood.

Efficiency of Low Power Laser Therapy on Pain and Suffering From Temporomandibular Dysfunction

Clinical exams were carried out to define the side with the major TMD symptom which was then treated with a 790 nm wavelength laser for 1.5 joules on each of four points of the temporomandibular joint and of 3 joules

on each of three points in the temporal muscle. Conclusion: laser therapy caused immediate relaxation of the evaluated masseter and temporal muscles and consequent relief of the major symptom.

Effects of Laser Photobiomodulation (660 nm and 830 nm) On The Healing Of Surgical Wounds

Groups 2 and 5 were treated with laser therapy, receiving 20 joules per treatment of 660 nm laser light. Groups 3 and 6 received 20 joules per treatment of 830 nm laser light. Laser therapy was applied transcutaneously in four points around the wounded site and started immediately after surgery and was repeated at every 48th hour during the experimental time. The results evidenced a more precocious healing on Group 2 and an advanced maturation of the collagen matrix and advanced inflammatory response was seen on all irradiated groups when compared to their controls. It is concluded that laser therapy resulted in a better repair with a more advanced collagen formation, quick inflammatory response and less edema. Laser wounds had less contraction and no scarring.

Laser Photobiomodulation (660 nm or 780 nm) On The Healing of 3rd Degree Burns

Laser therapy - 660 nm or 780 nm with a total of 20 joules delivered per treatment on 3rd degree burns. Treatment was started immediately after burning in 4 points (5 joules each) around the burn and repeated at 24 hour intervals for 21 days. The results showed higher deposition of collagen fibers, larger amounts of granulation tissue, less edema, better inflammatory reaction and revascularization on laser-treated subjects. It is concluded that both wavelengths were capable of improving the healing of 3rd degree burns.

I have one of those necks that make a grinding sound when turned from side to side with some pain in the adjacent muscles. My medical team got me a transfusion of three units of blood to keep me going. Tests of my bone marrow showed that I had lymphoma, a form of blood cancer. I underwent Rituxan infusion therapy which in 30 days brought my H. number up to 11.7. By May '08 it had dropped back to 10.8. I hid from my medical team and began using the Q1000 on my pelvic bones in hopes that would activate the production of red blood cells. By June '08 my H. number was back up to 11.0 and in July '08 it is up to 11.6 - which is very encouraging. I will continue with the Q1000 treatments and share my success with my medical team.

Another of my maladies is squamous cell carcinoma, small scaly growths. After having

one removed surgically, I have been working on them with the Q1000. I can not say that the laser kills the cancer (*Note from Dr. Lytle: it does not kill the cancer, but rather helps the body's immune system overcome the cancer naturally.*) but the growths shrink and the scaly tops fall off, leaving only a reminder of what was there - or nothing at all.

I will continue to enjoy my new healing tool and share it with those around me who are willing to grasp something that you cannot hold, chew or swallow. It is sort of like offering the Gospel, some people have trouble accepting the intangible and all that it promises.
